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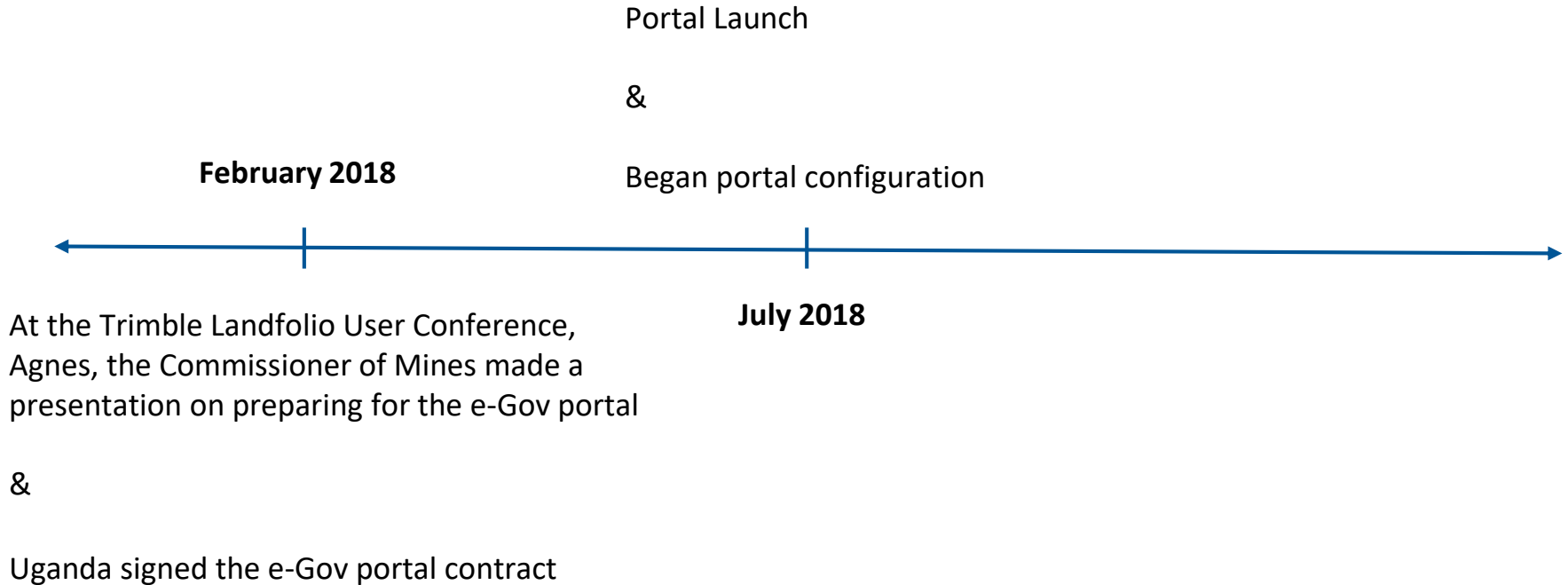

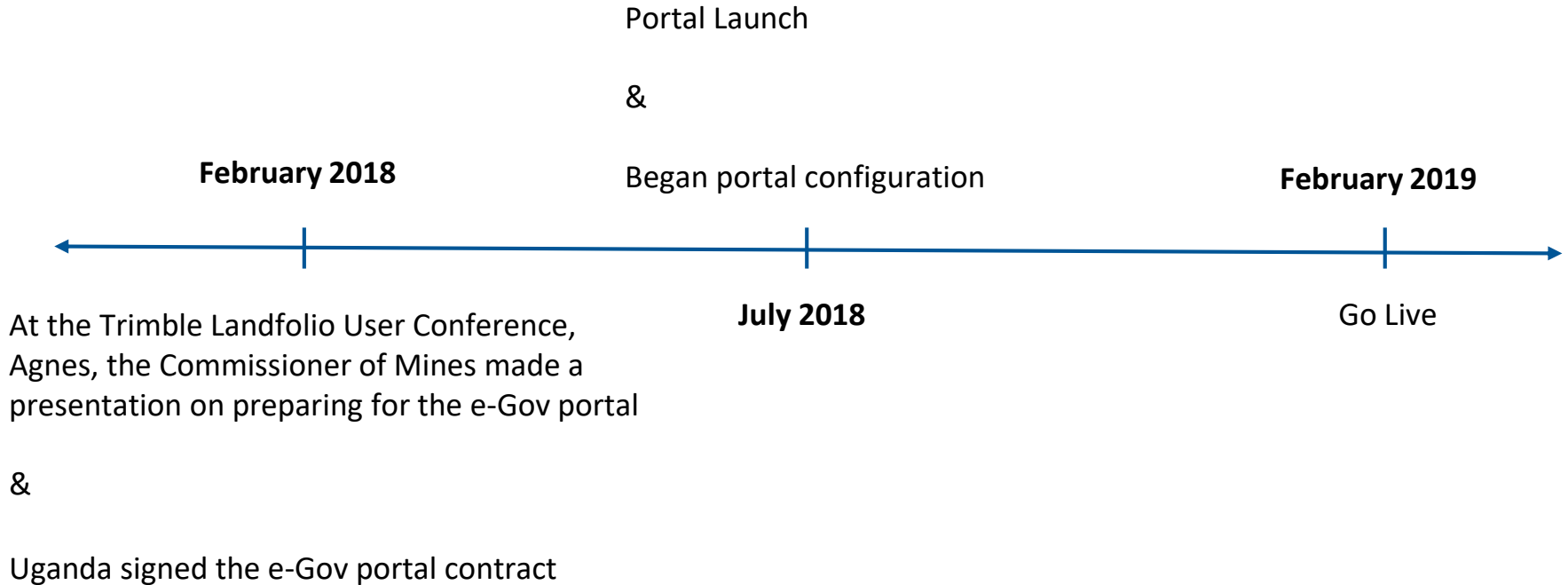
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Expectations for the Uganda e-Gov Portal:

- To make more government services accessible online
- To reduce the cost of accessing government services
- To reduce dependence on a manual filing system
- To reduce the time taken to process applications
- To make more time for compliance monitoring
- To make secure online payments
- To increase revenue (royalties, rents and other fees)



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- Payments/Revenue
 - Secure online payments
 - Revenue reporting to be done directly from the system
 - Focus on collecting outstanding funds (Payment default check)
